



ROLEX BRACELET EXTENSION SYSTEMS

COMFORTABLE AND FUNCTIONAL

Aesthetically pleasing yet robust, Rolex watch bracelets are designed to offer the wearer maximum comfort. In addition, Rolex has developed and patented ingenious extension systems that are simple and functional, making the watch a pleasure to wear in any circumstances.



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The innovative extension systems developed by Rolex do not require the use of tools and enable the wearer to use their watch in any conditions.

EASYLINK COMFORT EXTENSION LINK

The Easylink comfort extension link allows the wearer to easily adjust the bracelet length for additional comfort. Discreetly integrated and tucked beneath the clasp cover, this extension system comprises a link that is easily pulled out or folded back on itself to lengthen or shorten the bracelet by approximately 5 mm.

All Rolex timepieces equipped with an Oyster bracelet – except divers' watches – as well as the Sky-Dweller, Datejust 36 and Datejust 41 fitted with a Jubilee bracelet feature the Easylink comfort extension link. It is also present on versions of the Cosmograph Daytona with an Oysterflex bracelet, in addition to the Yacht-Master 37 and Yacht-Master 40 – watches offered exclusively on this elastomer bracelet.

ROLEX GLIDELOCK FINE-ADJUSTMENT SYSTEM

Rolex developed the Rolex Glidelock extension system so that its divers' watches could be worn comfortably over a diving suit. This particularly inventive mechanism, patented by the brand, enables fine-increment adjustment of the bracelet length using a fixed rack under the clasp cover.

The Submariner, Submariner Date, Sea-Dweller and Rolex Deepsea are fitted with a Rolex Glidelock that, on the Oyster bracelet, has 10 increments of approximately 2 mm, allowing the bracelet length to be increased by some 20 mm. This allows the watches to be worn over a diving suit up to 3 mm thick. The rack of the Rolex Glidelock system on the Rolex Deepsea can be lifted, allowing the bracelet length to be adjusted without having to remove the watch from the wrist.

The Rolex Glidelock also features on versions of the Yacht-Master 40, Yacht-Master 42 and the Sky-Dweller fitted with an Oysterflex bracelet. The length of this elastomer bracelet can therefore be adjusted by around 15 mm in increments of approximately 2.5 mm.

FLIPLOCK EXTENSION LINK

Composed of three folding pieces that are hidden beneath the clasp cover, the Fliplock extension link can be found on the Oyster bracelet that equips the Rolex Deepsea and the Oystersteel version of the Sea-Dweller. It enables the bracelets to be extended by approximately 26 mm.



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The Rolex Deepsea and the Sea-Dweller in Oystersteel feature both the Fliplock extension link and the Rolex Glidelock. When both systems are used together, the watches can be worn over diving suits up to 7 mm thick.
